NOW READ WHAT SAM ADAMSON FROM CHARNEY DID WITH HIS GRANT!

Sam received a grant from CLET towards a combined rugby and volunteering trip to South Africa and Namibia.

"My trip to South Africa and Namibia gave me an insight into the lives of people in a very different part of the world, from gated communities in the suburbs of Pretoria to the lives of children in the township of Swakopmund in Namibia.

In Swakopmund we painted a toilet block, repaired fencing and set wooden poles into the ground but the largest project was the construction of a patio. During breaks from this tiring work we spent time playing with the children that the project supports. We helped out with puzzles and jigsaws and played football in an open space to the rear of the project. The children asked for endless piggy backs, while some of the shyer ones just sat quietly talking. It was a wonderful experience and made you appreciate just how lucky we are to live in a country such as Britain.

During the trip I was hosted by local families and while staying with them I got to experience the different culture, sampling the local springbok cuisine and even sitting in on an Afrikaans lesson. I thoroughly enjoyed every aspect of the trip and I am very grateful that CLET supported me so that I could gain experiences that are a once in a lifetime opportunity."
