UPDATE ON CHILDREN'S PLAY EQUIPMENT

CHAFT (Charney Hall & Field Trust) has submitted its grant application to Vale of White Horse District Council for £9,000 towards the total cost (£24,000) of replacing and extending the children's play equipment on Charney Field. We expect to hear the result of our application to the Vale by the end of July. However, we cannot be sure that we will get all we have asked for. We already have £14,000 committed from CHAFT's designated fund for this purpose and £1,000 provided by the recent village fundraising efforts (Family Fun Day and May Day). If Vale's contribution falls short, then CHAFT will seek to apply for further grants and with your help we will raise more money to achieve our target. Thanks to Diane Ewart and Helen Royan for all their hard work in preparing the on-line application and to all in the village who have helped to raise funds for this both this year and over the last five years


