Offenders brought to justice

October has been a busy month for Faringdon Neighbourhood team. Offenders brought to justice have included:

- Two individuals charged for producing cannabis and possession with intent to supply following the 270 cannabis plants being recovered from a unit at Chowle Farm, Great Coxwell near Faringdon. Bethany Daniels and Michael Vann have been bailed to attend Oxford Magistrates Court on 24 November 2015 to enter a plea.
- Sophie Humphrey and James Redman of Catkins Close, Faringdon were convicted of supplying cannabis. Following evidence being found suggesting they were dealing to people under 16 years old, Redman was sentenced to 15 months imprisonment. Humphrey was handed a 12 month sentence suspended for two years. They also forfeited over £1400 of cash seized at the time of the offence.
- A suspected arson at a barn near to the A338 and Steventon Road, East Hanney resulted in the closure of the road for some time whilst fire brigade extinguished the flame. Three young individuals have been interviewed and are being dealt with by our local CID at Abingdon.

Crime

There have been incidents of criminal damage around Faringdon. The offenders are being interviewed and dealt with. We are also continuing to receive reports of items being stolen from graveyards. Someone is removing our crime prevention signs from around the Ridgeway and other beauty spot car parks. We would be very keen to hear from anyone with information about these offences, please call us on the police non-emergency number 101.

Thames Valley Alert

Receive free local crime alerts and crime prevention advice by registering at www.thamesvalleyalert.co.uk today. This allows anyone who signs up to choose what updates they receive and how they would like to receive it. A new option includes receiving information via text but more traditional landline and email messages are still available. You can also filter the updates you receive by specifying the priority level of the messages you receive.
