<u>Background</u>

1 Earlier this year, the village communications team which looks after the village email management system, produces Charney Chatter and manages the village website (all on behalf of the Parish Council) agreed to investigate if and whether these communication channels should be utilised to record selected information covering the history of the village and its past activities.

2 It was noted that there are History Societies in Longworth & District, Denchworth and The Hanneys. The Longworth & District History Society also covers KBS, Hinton Waldrist and neighbouring hamlets and has undertaken some research in Charney Bassett (probate and wills).

Outcomes.

3 The Group will operate on a less formal basis than a Society and be called the Charney Bassett History Group. Subject to confirmation from the Parish Council the communications channels referred to in paragraph 1 above will be used to promote the Group, record appropriate information and act as a signpost to other sources of information.

4 The following subject areas are considered to be worthy of investigation over time:-

Memories of local villagers

Village events

Village Organisations

Newspaper cuttings

Photographs

Books and documents

Village buildings

World War 1 and World War 2

Church records and the Graveyard

Old and historic maps

County of Berkshire records.
