#### Anti-social behaviour (ASB)

As reported in last month's newsletter the increase in ASB at Tuckers Park has escalated to offences of Arson. We are pleased to say the offenders have been identified and dealt with accordingly. We will continue to deal with any ASB robustly. The neighbourhood team would like to request that if you see large groups of young people causing issues then let us know as soon as possible.

#### Offenders brought to justice

- The Faringdon team continues to take robust action against those involved with drugs, and following proactive work from PC Pryor, APS Maris and WPC Cannon, a male has been re-arrested for possession with intent to supply and facing prosecution.
- A male has been arrested for causing Harassment to the Watchfield Parish council and will be facing a prosecution.

We have had a small rise in Thefts from Motor Vehicles in our beauty spots. Can we please remind you NOT to leave valuables in your vehicles.
