VILLAGE TRAFFIC VOLUME AND SPEED SURVEY

On 10 May the Parish Council considered proposals by the Road Safety Group for a traffic volume and speed survey in the village using equipment provided by the County Council. If undertaken, this will need to be paid for by the Parish Council and the cost will depend on the number of locations monitored.

The Road Safety Group has now put forward favoured locations for monitoring points in Buckland Road, New Road, Longworth Road, Lyford Road and Denchworth Road.

Details will be presented at the Parish Council meeting on 12 July, providing an opportunity for residents to ask questions and for views to be expressed.

PLANNING APPLICATION

- Representatives from the Parish Council and CHAFT are to meet to discuss playing field management issues.








By popular demand the plant stall is back at Chequers. With an even larger variety of flowers and veg than last year all at a great price, it's well worth a visit.
